

Plant Descriptions

The best time to plant is 25 years ago, the second-best time is today.



Common Name: Vine Maple

***Acer circinatum* 'Pacific Fire'**

A small, multi-stemmed, upright vine maple tree. The bark is red and the leaves are a bright green in the spring and summer, turning to brilliant yellows, oranges, and reds in the fall.

A dense, upright vine maple tree. In the spring, leaves are maroon-red with orange overtones fading to red or bronze-green for summer. The fall color is orange to red.

A hybrid that is a cross between a red maple and a silver maple. The dense oval shape has deeply lobed green foliage that turns a brilliant orange and red in the fall.

An upright spreading maple tree with a rounded crown. Dark green trifoliate foliage becomes bright orange and red in the fall. Old bark peels to a cinnamon orange bark underneath.

An upright, compact maple tree. Large dark green leaves in the summer are deeply divided and in fall, the colors are a brilliant crimson/scarlet shading into purple. Aka 'Dancing Peacock'.

An upright, vase shaped Japanese maple tree. This tree has bright yellow bark with green leaves that turn yellow and orange in the fall.

An upright, rounded Japanese maple tree becoming broad topped with age. The purple/red foliage turns a scarlet red in the fall. Sun to partial shade.

A small, upright, round shaped Japanese maple tree. The dark red foliage turns red in the fall.

An upright shaped Japanese maple tree with purple red foliage. In fall, the leaves become scarlet and crimson in color. Sun to partial shade.

An upright shaped tree with delicate bamboo-like texture. In spring, the leaves are bright red and by fall, turn fiery oranges and reds.

A broad upright with narrow, string-like, deeply divided leaf lobes. Branch structure is dense & twiggy. Leaves have a hint of red in spring, are green in summer and turn to yellow in fall. Bark is bright green and graceful. Sun to partial shade.

A shrubby Japanese maple. In spring, the leaves emerge yellow with a pink border. By fall, the leaves turn a bright orange/red that turn eventually again to a deep red.

A compact, multi-branched bush. The green leaves grow closely together, overlapping one another like shingles on a roof creating a dense leaf cover. The leaves turn a vivid fiery red and darker red in fall. Sun to partial shade.

Small upright Japanese maple tree with brilliant coral bark on the young branches. Light green leaves become gold in the fall. Sun to partial shade.

This is a medium sized maple with brilliant red spring color. It gradually changes to mottled red to green in the summer and yellows, oranges, and reds in the fall months.

An upright, vase shaped Japanese maple tree that is compact and shrubby. Crinkled green foliage turns gold with rose and crimson in the fall.

A narrow upright shaped shrub-like Japanese maple tree. The dark red foliage maintains its color through the season. After the leaves drop, the branches darken to a deep red. Sun to partial shade.

The tall shrub like Japanese maple tree is semi-dense. The foliage is light green with shades of pink and white becoming orange in the fall. Sun to partial shade.

A weeping Japanese maple shrub with deep red finely dissected foliage that holds its color well in summer. Fall foliage is scarlet. Sun to partial shade.

A Japanese maple with a round, weeping mounded habit. The foliage is a deep purple/red that turns to crimson in the fall. Slow growing.

A weeping Japanese maple shrub with bright orange/red foliage in spring turning brown/red with green in summer. Fall foliage is a bright orange/red. Moderate grower.

A weeping, mounded Japanese maple shrub. The deep purple/red leaves are deeply dissected. Fall foliage is a bright red.

A weeping, mounded Japanese maple tree. The bright green leaves in spring are tipped in red and yellow/orange in the fall.

A weeping Japanese maple mound with deeply cut purple/red foliage that becomes bright red in the fall.

This Japanese maple shrub forms a weeping mound. The deeply cut bright green foliage turns orange in the fall.

This Japanese maple tree has cascading branches with finely cut leaves that are green in the spring and gold in the fall.

An oval shaped Norway maple tree when young, becoming rounded with age. Foliage is a deep purple turning reddish/bronze in the fall.

A large pyramidal shaped maple tree. The foliage is a dark glossy green that turns a brilliant orange/red.

A rounded oval shaped maple tree with a dense crown. Medium green foliage turns a deep red to reddish purple in the fall. Moderate to fast growing.

An upright, oval variety of sugar maple trees with dark green foliage in the summer and orange-red color in the fall.

A multi-stemmed serviceberry tree with a rounded form. In the spring, it has clusters of pink flowers and then dark green foliage. In the fall, the leaves turn a red-orange.

An open branched oval shaped birch tree with bright white bark. The dark green foliage turns yellow in the fall.

A white birch with a twisted trunk. The slender, weeping branches create a graceful mound. Foliage is green becoming yellow in the fall.

An evergreen boxwood shrub with an upright, cone shaped habit that makes an excellent hedge when clipped. The foliage is bright green.

An evergreen boxwood shrub with a dense, upright mound of small, glossy foliage that starts as bright lime green in spring and deepens to dark green for visual interest.

The serpentine trunk sports weeping branchlets with blue needles. This attractive cedar conifer can be trained into interesting shapes for a dramatic landscape.

A pyramidal form cedar tree with blue/green foliage. It is narrow in shape with branches that grow at an ascending angle instead of horizontal or sweeping downwards.

An oval shaped redbud tree with light green heart shaped foliage. White flowers appear in the spring.

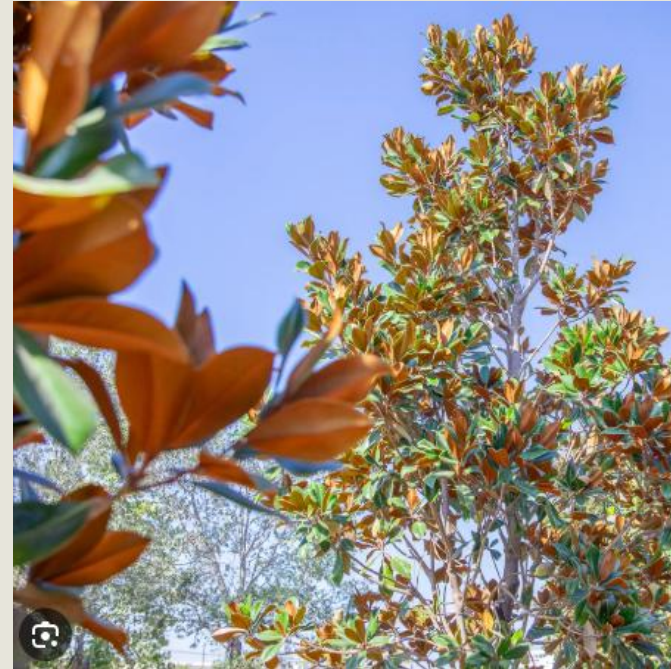


A narrow cone-like tree with bright green foliage. Large reddish/purple flowers that appear in late spring.

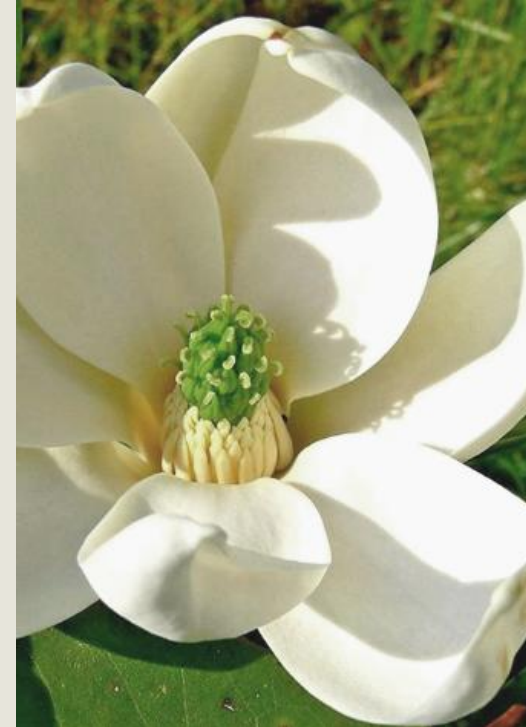

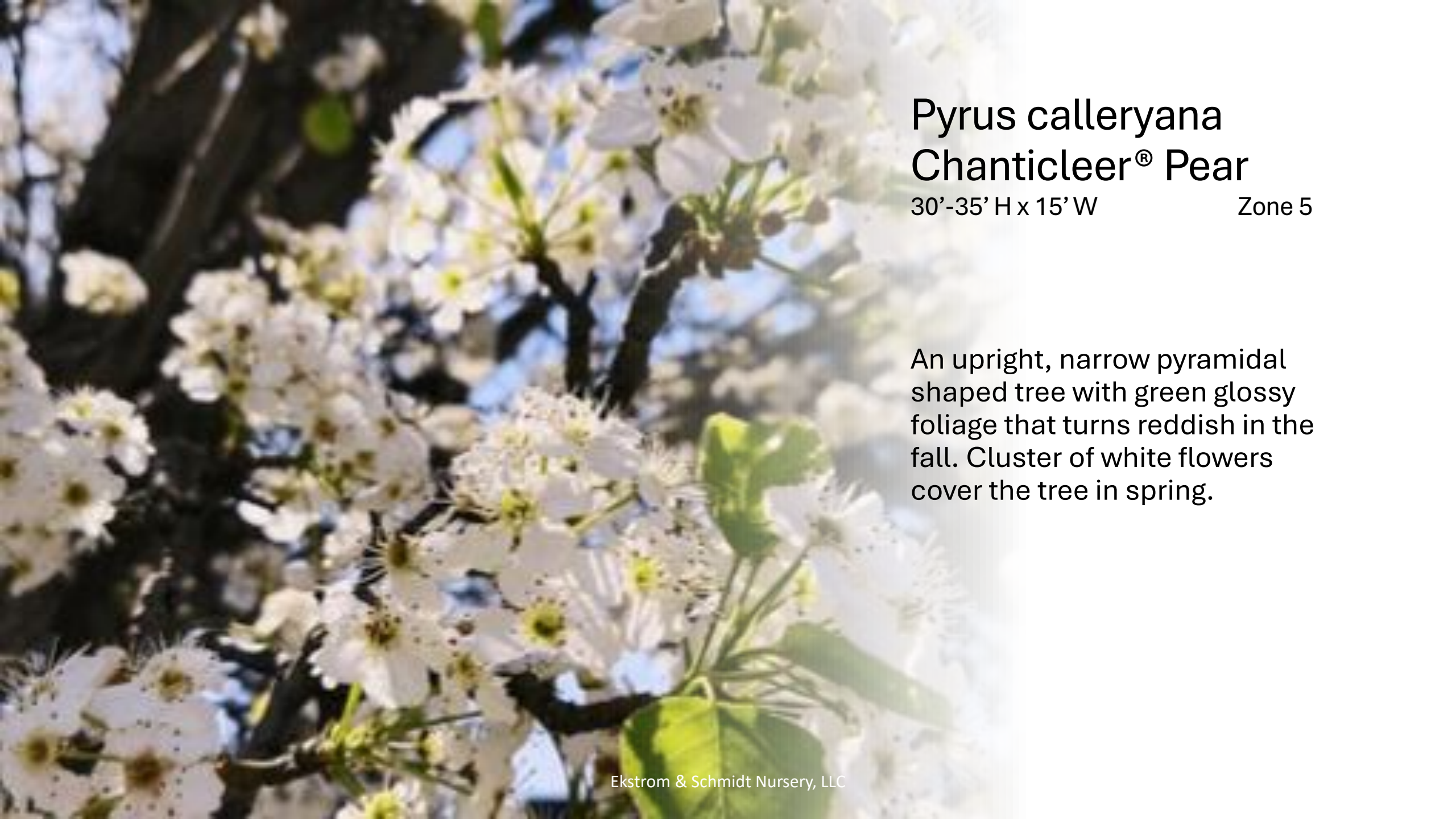
